
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Ensuring compliance of the price capping of the coronary stents along with maintaining its uninterrupted supply – regarding.

The undersigned is directed to state that, the Department of Pharmaceuticals vide its notification No. 31026/05/2007-Pricing, dated 21/02/2017 by invoking powers of Section 3 (i) of DPCO, 2013 has directed all the companies manufacturing coronary stents in India to maintain production/import/supply of the coronary stents and to submit a weekly report on coronary stents produced and distributed. They have also been directed to submit a weekly production plan to NPPA and DCGI. This order will be valid for six months and NPPA and DCGI will recommend withdrawal or extension as the case may be, two weeks before the expiry of the period.

2. As per the above notification of the Department of Pharmaceuticals all manufacturers/importers/marketers of coronary stents are required to submit a weekly report on coronary stents. However, it has been found that, the manufactures/importers of coronary stents have not followed the instructions of the Department of Pharmaceuticals so far as no weekly report has been received in NPPA in this regard.

3. Therefore, all manufactures/importers/marketers of coronary stents are once again directed to follow the direction of the Department of Pharmaceuticals and to submit a weekly report on coronary stents produced and distributed as per the proforma attached. Non-compliance of these instructions shall be taken up for prosecution under relevant provisions of Essential Commodities Act.
